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### Education Abroad

Please note that the HIS 101, 102 and 103 seminar requirement may not be satisfied abroad (with the exception of students participating in the Summer Abroad Program in Vienna, HIS 102S).

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### Honors Program

Students who complete the year long Honors Thesis Program (HIS 104A, 104B, 104C) may substitute 104B and 104C for any course in either Plan, with the exception of HIS 102. Please note that you must complete the entire series to receive credit toward the major. Partial credit will not be given.
